**Fellow Membership** is the highest level of individual recognition within AGILE-HRP®, awarded to distinguished professionals who have demonstrated exceptional leadership, scholarly contribution, industry impact, or thought leadership in HR, leadership, or project domains.

Fellows represent the top 1% of certified professionals in their respective fields and are recognized as global authorities and change-makers.

## FELLOWSHIP FEES & STRUCTURE

One-Time Assessment & Review Fee	\$300 USD (non-refundable)
Renewal Cycle	Every 3 years, subject to activity and contribution review



# ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To qualify for Fellowship consideration, applicants must meet the following:

- Minimum **15 years of progressive leadership experience** in HR, leadership, or project roles
- Demonstrated contributions to the profession through:
  - Publications, research, or teaching
  - Executive leadership roles in global or high-impact organizations
  - Development of standards, systems, or frameworks used in industry
- Must hold at least one chartered-level AGILE-HRP® certification (e.g., CSLM®, CHRM®, COLC®) or equivalent senior-level credential
- Endorsement from two recognized industry professionals or academics
- Submission of:
  - CV or professional portfolio
  - Statement of professional impact
  - Fellowship assessment application (reviewed by the Board)

# FELLOWSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

Fellows are expected to:

- Maintain ethical and professional standards at the highest level
- Contribute actively through mentorship, writing, or committee participation
- Renew status every 3 years by submitting an updated impact report or CPD portfolio
- Promote AGILE-HRP® and its mission in your professional networks
- Actively participate in at least one initiative annually (e.g., judging panel, webinar, advisory)

## FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

### Step 1: Expression of Interest

Submit an online application form and CV through [www.agilehrp.org](http://www.agilehrp.org) or request a fellowship information package by email.

### Step 2: Document Submission

Provide:

- Completed application form
- Updated resume/CV
- Personal statement (max 1,000 words): "My Impact in HR, Leadership, or Project Excellence"
- Two letters of endorsement

### Step 3: Review and Evaluation

The Fellowship Review Committee conducts:

- A credential verification
- Assessment of career impact and strategic leadership
- Interview (if required)

### Step 4: Notification and Onboarding

If accepted:

- Pay the **annual fee (\$2,800)** and **assessment fee (\$300)**
- Receive formal acceptance letter, welcome packet, and onboarding access
- Gain entry into the **AGILE-HRP® Fellows Circle**

# ANNUAL FELLOWSHIP SUMMIT & GLOBAL HONORS

Each year, Fellows are invited to a Global Honors Ceremony during the AGILE-HRP® International Leadership & Talent Transformation Summit, where new inductees are honored and existing Fellows are recognized for their contributions.

This prestigious gathering connects influential leaders, researchers, and innovators across sectors and geographies.

## CONTINUING FELLOWSHIP & RENEWAL

Fellowship is maintained for a **three-year cycle** and renewed by submitting:

- An updated professional portfolio
- Summary of contributions (mentorship, events, writing, board service)
- Any additional CPD or recognition gained during the period

Failure to meet contribution requirements may result in status reassessment.
