1. OVERVIEW

The Global Institute for Leadership, Human Resources, and Project Excellence® (AGILE HRP®) is a U.S. chartered nonprofit dedicated to certifying elite professionals in agile HR, strategic leadership, project management, and transformation excellence. Members gain recognition, credibility, and access to global networks and resources through professional credentials and continuing development.

2. MEMBERSHIP TYPES & ANNUAL FEES

AGILE HRP® offers five main membership categories:

- 1. **Professional Membership** Ideal for early- to mid-career practitioners in HR, leadership, or project disciplines.
- 2. **Corporate Membership** Enables teams and organizations to harness bulk benefits and institutional access.
- 3. **Fellow Membership** Exclusive tier for highly experienced professionals and thought leaders.
- 4. **Chartered Professional Membership** For members who have obtained Chartered-level certification (e.g. CSLM®, CHRM®, CAHPM®).
- 5. **Student Membership** For currently enrolled students pursuing AGILE HRP® certifications.

Fees: Specific annual dues vary by level and region. Still, standard Professional or Corporate membership begins at **\$150 USD/year** (estimated based on affiliate pricing structure).

MEMBERSHIP TYPES & ANNUAL FEES BREAKDOWN

AGILE-HRP® offers a range of membership types designed to support professionals at every stage of their HR, leadership, or project management journey-from students to senior executives and institutions. Each membership tier comes with tailored benefits, exclusive access, and recognition aligned with your level of expertise and contribution.

1. PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Annual Fee: \$250 USD

Who Should Join:

This membership is ideal for early-career and mid-level professionals working in human resources, talent management, leadership development, agile project delivery, or organizational effectiveness roles.

Key Benefits:

- Access to all AGILE-HRP® core certifications at discounted rates
- Digital membership ID and badge
- · Access to member-only resources and toolkits
- Continuing Professional Development (CPD) tracking and learning credits
- Networking through AGILE-HRP chapters, forums, and virtual events

Eligibility:

Professionals with at least 1 year of experience or holding relevant qualifications in HR, leadership, or project-related fields.

2. CHARTERED PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Annual Fee: None

Exam Fee Only (Varies by certification)

Overview:

Chartered Membership is granted to individuals who successfully complete an AGILE HRP® Chartered Certification (e.g., CSLM®, CHRM®, COLC®). Once chartered, members are recognized as elite professionals within their domain.

Key Benefits:

- · Chartered status is earned by examination only
- No annual membership fee is required after chartering
- Certification is valid for 3 years, after which it must be renewed by completing CPD requirements or a renewal exam
- Chartered members receive lifetime access to AGILE HRP® community forums, digital badges, and alumni privileges

Eligibility:

Applicants must pass the required AGILE HRP® chartered certification exam. No automatic admission without examination.

3. FELLOW MEMBERSHIP

Annual Fee: \$2,800 USD

One-Time Assessment Fee: \$300 USD

Overview:

Fellow Membership is the highest level of individual recognition offered by AGILE HRP®. It is designed for senior executives, subject matter experts, industry thought leaders, and academic scholars with exceptional contributions to human capital, leadership, or project transformation.

Key Benefits:

- Title of Fellow of AGILE HRP® (FAGILE)
- Priority invitation to serve on global boards, committees, and certification councils
- Leadership roles in shaping standards, frameworks, and new credential programs
- Speaking opportunities at global events and summits
- Premium access to restricted research, publications, and executive briefings
- Featured profile on the AGILE HRP® website and directories

Eligibility:

Candidates must demonstrate 15+ years of senior experience and contributions to the field. Selection is based on application, professional references, and a credentials review process. The \$300 assessment fee covers portfolio review, interview, and evaluation.

Annual Fee: \$3,000 USD (Base fee for up to 10 staff members; volume-based pricing available) **Overview:**


Corporate Membership allows institutions, consulting firms, academic bodies, and public agencies to provide certification and training access to their workforce.

Key Benefits:

- Up to 10 employee memberships included
- 30% discount on all exams and certifications for company employees
- Authority to conduct and proctor virtual exams onsite
- · Customized onboarding and team-level learning plans
- Co-branded certifications and tailored workshops
- Public listing in the AGILE HRP® Corporate Partner Directory
- Access to quarterly CPD reporting and performance tracking

Eligibility:

Open to any registered organization supporting HR, leadership, or project-based development for internal or client teams.

5. STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Annual Fee: \$75 USD

Overview:


This category supports undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees in HR, business, organizational psychology, public administration, or project management. Student members receive early access to foundational learning and career development support.

Key Benefits:

- Discounted fees for foundational certifications (e.g., CHRG®, CPPL®)
- Access to student-centered webinars, mentorship programs, and learning forums
- Digital student membership badge and participation certificate
- Opportunity to transition into professional membership upon graduation

Eligibility:

Must be currently enrolled in an accredited academic institution. Proof of enrollment required. A valid student ID or enrollment letter is required.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Membership Validity: All memberships are valid for one year from the date of approval.
- **Renewal:** Renewal notices will be sent 30 days prior to expiration. CPD may be required for some tiers.
- **Upgrade Path:** Members may apply to upgrade to higher tiers (e.g., from Professional to Chartered or Fellow) based on experience and credentialing.

5. HOW TO JOIN OR UPGRADE

Membership process:

- 1. Visit agilehrp.org ??Become a Member ??Choose your tier
- 2. Complete the online membership application
- 3. Upload proof of eligibility if applicable (e.g. certification, student ID)
- 4. Submit annual membership fee via card or bank wire
- 5. Receive welcome email, member portal access, and soft credential (digital badge)

For Chartered or Fellow levels, you may be asked to provide a CV, certification evidence, and attend a review session.

6. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Q: What's included with CEXEL® certification?

Q: Are there language options or group programs?

A: Yes—AGILE HRP® partners deliver in-house or group programs in English and other languages, especially for Corporate members.

Q: What is the membership renewal policy?
